

## 4" Box

The largest of our Box patterns, the 4" Box quilts perfectly with heavier weight wadding and foam.

Great for use in bedding and upholstery.

Dimensions: 15cm x 15cm (point to point)

### 2" Box

The most popular of our pattern range, the 2" Box lends itself to a multitude of products including fashion outerwear, workwear, linings, soft furnishings and equestrian.

Recommended wadding - medium weight and wool.

Dimensions: 7.5cm x 7.5cm (point to point)

# $\frac{1}{4}$ Box

This smaller Box pattern quilts perfectly with lighter weight waddings, wools and dense needlepoly.

The perfect pattern for nursery, homewares and equestrian.

Dimensions: 5cm x 5cm (point to point)

# 5 Box 8

The smallest of our patterns using lighter weight wadding.

Perfect for equestrian, accessories, linings/panels.

Dimensions: 2.5cm x 2.5cm



### 6x4 Diamond

Our largest Diamond.
As with the 4" Box this pattern can be quilted with heavier weight wadding and foam.

Great for outerwear, bedding and upholstery.

Dimensions: 10cm x 15cm (point to point).

## 3x2 Diamond

A quilting classic, the 3x2 Diamond is versatile to most wadding weights and finished products, including fashion, homeware, workwear, dressage, equestrian, linings and bedding.

Dimensions: 7.5cm x 5cm (point to point)

# 5 Diamond

The small
Diamond for
lighter weight
wadding and wool.

Perfect for accessories, equestrian, and linings/panels.

Dimensions: 2.5cm x 3.75cm

# Wavy Diamond

Diamond with a wave, with dimensions the same as the 3x2 Diamond, and quilts to light to medium wadding weights and wool.

Used in healthcare, fashion and accessories.


Dimensions: 7.5cm x 5cm (point to point)

# Large Wavy Diamond

Large Diamond with a wave effect, quilts with heavier weight waddings, foam and wool.

Used in healthcare, equestrian, upholstery and fashion.

Dimensions: 12cm x 16cm (point to point)



### 1" Vertical

Also known as 'baffle' or 'channel' quilt. Stitching runs down the length of the fabric and stitch lines can be increased by inches.

Narrower spacing for lighter weight waddings, wider channel for heavier weights of wadding.

Commonly used in horse rugs, bedding and construction.

**Dimensions: From 1" Increments** 

### 3" Vertical

Also known as 'baffle' or 'channel' quilt. Stitching runs down the length of the fabric and stitch lines can be increased by inches.

Narrower spacing for lighter weight waddings, wider channel for increased weights of wadding.

Commonly used in horse rugs, bedding and construction.

**Dimensions:** From 1" Increments

# Point Wave

Stitches the length of the cloth, the point wave is a vertical with a 'twist'. An unusual pattern, and can be used for most products and wadding type and weight.

Popular in the fashion industry.

Dimensions: 9cm (point to point on the diagonal)

# 1" Chevron

The Small Chevron (Zig-Zag) vertical stitching, the width can be increased in inch increments and perfect for any wadding type and weight.

Used in equestrian, fashion, accessories.

Dimensions: 3.5cm (point to point).

# Chevron with Gap

Small Chevron design with a difference.

Stitch settings can be altered to give the Chevron a different look.

Used in equestrian, homeware, fashion and accessories.


**Dimensions: 3.5cm** 

# Elongated Chevron

Wider angled chevron, the width can be increased in inch increments, and medium to heavier weight wadding.

Used in equestrian, homeware, fashion and linings.

Dimensions: 9cm (point to point on the diagonal)



## Onion

A smooth 'Onion' shape, quilts vertically. Very versatile to wadding types and weights.

Applications include outerwear, fashion, workwear and uniform.

Dimensions: 5cm x 7cm

# Chicken Wire Very small Onion, light wadding. Used in equestrian, fashion and accessories **Dimensions:** 3cm x 2.5cm

# Military Onion

A classic pattern, originally created for Army jackets, now loved by the fashion industry.
Light to medium wadding weights.

Used in outerwear and accessories.

#### **Dimension:**

9.5cm (across the centre) and approx. 1cm between the two curves.

#### Small Waves

A contemporary oval shaped pattern overlapping the shapes.

Lighter weight wadding and wool.

Used in outerwear, nursery products, equestrian, fashion and accessories.

Dimension:
7cm point to point
4cm centre curve



#### WADDING

We quilt with most wadding types and weights, ranging from Polyester to Wool.

#### Polyester

Wadding with a blend of staple polyester fibres, meets BS5852 Part 2 and relevant requirements of the Furniture and Furnishing (Fire Safety) regulations.

Weights: 70g; 100g; 135g; 200g; 300g; 400g; 500g

#### **PET Recycled Fibre**

Manufactured with 100% polyester fibre of which 70% - 80% comes from recycled plastic bottles. These Fibres are processed by carding

- to separate the fibres and then layered to give overall thickness.
- · PET Fibre has Zero GWP (Global Warming Potential)
- · PET Fibre has Zero ODP (Ozone Depletion Potential)

Weights: 70g; 100g; 135g; 200g; 300g; 400g; 500g

#### **Active Wool**

#### 75% Wool / 25% PLA Fibre

Beyond its environmental prowess, wool brings a host of technical advantages. Certified traceable fibres are hand selected and processed to create machine washable performance insulation that is breathable, soft, anti-bacterial and odour-resistant.

Applications - Outwear, sleeping bags, apparel, accessories

Weights: 75gsm - 200gsm

#### 100% Wool

100% Wool brings a host of natural advantages. Certified traceable wool fibres are hand selected and processed mechanically to create a systematised and resilient insulation of varying weights, suitable for outdoor apparel, accessories, and workwear.

Applications - Outwear, sleeping bags, apparel, accessories. Weights: 125gsm - 200gsm

All our wadding is FR. Test Certificates and Wash Care Instructions can be provided on request.

Our threads are available in a variety of colours.
